Washrooms are located at the Ross Street parking lot at the corner of Hudson and Ross, across from Pharmasave. A few blocks away, there are washrooms at Fletcher Park on 2nd Avenue, right across from the fire hall.

If you're wandering around by the wharf, you can find washrooms in-between Marine Peace Park and the parking lot.

And of course there are washrooms at the Tourist Information Centre located at 20 Hudson Avenue N.E., just off the Trans Canada Highway.
