



Salmon Arm Fall Fair

Although everyone is a little sad when the lazy days of summer vacation are coming to a close, the one bright spot is the Salmon Arm Fall Fair which takes place from September 10 to 12, 2010.

The fair is a very old tradition as it's celebrating its 113th anniversary this year. The fair has retained its old-fashioned feel even though it has modern categories such as Lego artwork for the kids.

The fair attracts thousands of visitors but the large fairgrounds easily accommodate the crowd so it never feels overwhelming. There are the sounds of animals in the barns, the smell of cotton candy and the delighted squeals of children on the amusement rides, and many exhibits to enjoy.

Exhibits range from baking, crafts, photography, fruits, vegetables and flowers, to llamas, cattle, horses, sheep and goats.

Horses are shown throughout the weekend, with a light horse show with an extensive variety of classes, pony driving, horse driving, heavy horse pull, miniature horse show, and log skidding.

Other features of the fair include: old-time trades; sheep-shearing and sheep-to-shawl competitions; local antique tractor display and threshing demonstrations; lawnmower races; scarecrow competition; logging show; memory lane; 4-H shows; midway; parade; Shuswap Idols contest; entertainment.

4-H clubs form an integral part of the Salmon Arm Fair and it's fun to watch the young people exhibit their cows and goats.

There's a lot of entertainment including the mutt show and pet parade.

The parade on Saturday morning is a fun family event and viewing the colourful activity is a necessary part of creating childhood memories.
