Jim's Ford Corral Museum

Step back in time

Take a step back in time at Jim's Ford Corral Museum. This is no ordinary museum; it is filled with gas-station memorabilia, farm equipment and scale-model toys. There are horse-drawn farm equipment, service station signs and a replica of an old-time general store.

The museum is located at 1822 Davies Road, Sorrento. Actually it is almost six kilometres from Sorrento or eight kilometres from the Trans Canada and Balmoral Road junction. Follow Notch Hill Road to cross the tracks onto Davies Road, and go down Davies for 1.6 kms to the museum. The museum is open on the weekends or by appointment. Phone 250-835-8349.
