Music by the River is a series of free concerts performed near the Shuswap River. The concerts begin at 7 p.m. except for the September concert, which starts at 3 p.m. Bring chairs or a rug. The concerts are free but donations are welcomed. Dress warmly as necessary.

June 27 – Belvidere Park in Enderby, “Half a Quorum” quartet from Vernon led by Steve Todd play rhythm and blues, country and 40’s swing.

July 11 - Putula Park in Mara, “Old Man’s Beard” quintet performing bluegrass, country and jazz.

July 25 – Belvidere Park in Enderby, “Evans Sisters and band Top Dawgs” to play folk, soft rock and country.

August 7 – Grindrod Park in Grindrod, “Saskia and Darrel DelaRonde from Saskatchewan will sing prairie folk music as part of Grindrod’s Centennial celebrations.

August 29 – Belvidere Park in Enderby, “Ash” trio from Vernon perform country, folk, rhythm and blues.

September 26 – Belvidere Park at 3 p.m. “A Day Late and a Dollar Short” bluegrass band from Kelowna will play in conjunction with BC Rivers Day.

Interpretive Centre

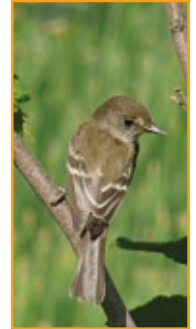
